**"After the service I met the Bible students. One of the young men spent two months in jail. His church was raided and he was arrested. He volunteered to go to jail if the police would free one of the young ladies.**

Going to jail in Laos is nothing like going to jail in America. For two months, Song lived in a cage that was only four feet high. He was unable to stand up straight. The guards raised chicken on the roof of the cage, and Song slept in their dung. He was forced to sleep on his stomach so the dung would not cover his mouth while he slept. At the end of the first month his family was not able to raise his \$60 fine and he had to spend another month in that cage. All because he went to church. Song desperately **wants to become a preacher."**

Why not say a prayer for Song right now? And why not thank God for our freedom of assembly in America! Tomorrow is Flag Day - fly the flag!
