## Did You Know....

- ▶ 85% of all churches in America are either plateaued or are declining in their attendance.
  - ▶ There are 195 million non-churched people in America, making America one of the largest "unchurched" nations in the world.
  - ▶ Each year 3,500 - 4,000 churches in America close their doors forever. There are 400,000 churches in America. That 1%. In 10 years, that's 10%.
  - ▶ During the last 10 years, combined communicant membership of all protestant denominations declined by 9.5% (4,498,242) while the national population increased by 11.4% (24,153,000).
