Sermon Review - The 7 Ministry Gifts

Text: Romans 12:4-8

There are 7 Ministry gifts the Holy Ghost equips the members of the church with to edify each other. Which one(s) is/are yours?

1. Preacher - v 6 Forthtelling the Word of God in an assembly.
2. Server - v 7 Those who execute the commands or wishes of others, relieving leadership to do other things.
3. Teacher - v 7 To give a discourse or an illustration that instructs others. Assembly settings of different sizes and ages.
4. Counselor - v 8 Exhortation, one who gives strong, healthy counsel to another. Usually on a one-on-one basis.
5. Giver - v 8 Philanthropist. Those who give above and beyond for the benefit of others and future generations.
6. Organizer - v 8 Ruling, administration, organization
7. Comforter - v 8 Showing mercy, giving care to the wounded.

Each has one gift to use and should be a good steward of it. (1 Peter 4:10) As we mature in our walk with the Holy Ghost, all seven should begin to manifest in some way.

Sermon Review - The 3 Most Common Forms of Praise

Text: Psalm 150:6

"Praise" is mentioned about 300 times in the Bible. It is a discipline and duty of every believer. The Bible mentions forms of praise such as clapping, leaping, dancing (not like on TV), shouting, but the most common 3 are:

1. Saying it - Hebrews 13:15 (mentions 240x in the Bible)
2. Singing it - Judges 5:3 (mentioned 40x in the Bible)
3. Sounding - 1 Chronicles 23:5 (mentioned 25x in the Bible)

Praise is as much of the Christian life as prayer is. Say it! Can you learn to sing? Can you learn an instrument? Teach your kids music, or buy lessons.
