(Genesis 3; Isaiah 24:5-6)

Fact #90

Justice Understood

(Acts 17:30-31)

Our God-given conscience reveals that all sin will be judged. Down deep we know that He who created the eyes sees every secret sin (Romans 2:16). He who formed our mind remembers our past offense as if it just occurred. God has declared that the penalty for sin is death.
