Known as "The Financier of the Revolution". Gave millions to the cause. Entered business life at fifteen as a tall, strong boy with a round face and thatch of sandy red hair. Good humored, with a pleasant personality, he was a diligent worker. His industry, integrity, and common sense won him the high respect of his employers.

He once said, "Religion is the only solid basis of good morals; therefore, education should teach the precepts of religion and the duties of man towards God."

The U.S. Supreme Court has already set a precedent about marriage between one man and one woman:



"Certainly no legislation can be supposed more wholesome and necessary in the founding of a free, self-governing commonwealth...than that which seeks to establish it on the basis of the idea of the family, as consisting in and springing from the union for life of **one man and one woman in the holy state of matrimony**; the sure foundation of all that is stable and noble in our civilization; the best guarantee of that reverent morality which is the source of all beneficent progress in social and political improvement."
