*John Morton*

**Signer #27:** John Morton (1724-1777)

Pennsylvania. Age at signing: 52

**Married:** Ann (8 children)

**Occupation:** Surveyor, Farmer

### Quotes & Notes:

John Morton, the first signer to die, didn't live to witness the liberty he sacrificed for: the sacrifice of his friendships and reputation. There were many supporters of reconciliation with Great Britain living in Pennsylvania, and many of his close friends turned against him for his stand for the patriots cause. On his death bed Morton cried out, "Tell them they will live to see the hour when they shall acknowledge it to have been the most glorious service that I ever rendered to my country."

He was buried in the cemetery of St. James Church in Chester, of which he was a member.

Mr. Morton was a professor of religion, and a truly excellent man. To the poor he was ever kind; and to an affectionate family, consisting of wife, three sons and five daughters, he was an affectionate husband and father.

### The Function of the Law
