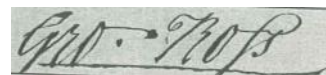

**Signer #28:** George Ross (1730-1779)

Pennsylvania. Age at signing: 46

**Married:** Anne (3 children)

**Occupation:** Lawyer, Jurist

### Quotes & Notes:

George Ross was born in New Castle, Delaware in 1730, the son of an Episcopal minister who took much care in teaching his son well. George became proficient in Latin and Greek, and at age 18 entered the law office of his brother in Philadelphia. He was admitted to the bar at age 21.

In January, 1777, he became ill with gout and retired from public office.

In his domestic habits he was kind, generous, beloved; in his professional career zealous and able; as a politician always active and patriotic he seems to have well deserved the praise bestowed on him by one who knew him, as honest man and upright judge.
