How did it produce offspring without a mate? If a female evolved, why did it evolve with differing reproductive organs. Signer #31: George Taylor (1716-1781)

Quotes & Notes:

George Taylors is one of two signers who least is known. He was born in Ireland, son of a minister, in 1716.

Desiring as a young man to come to America, but not having money for passage, he gave himself as an indentured servant, working for five years to pay for his passage. He was 20 years old when he sailed to Pennsylvania, indentured to Mr Savage in his iron foundry near Philidelphia. When Mr Savage learned George had received some education, he promoted him to clerk. Mr Savage died a few years later, and George married his widow Anne. They had two children. George became owner of the foundry, and by hard work increased the size of his business and attained a good fortune. They built a large home in Northampton, Pennsylvania.
