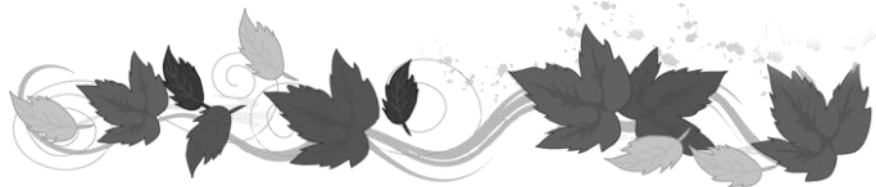

SIGNERS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

Benjamin Harrison

Signer #41: Benjamin Harrison (1726-1791)

Virginia. Age at signing: 50

Occupation: Planter

Married: Elizabeth (7 children)

Quotes & Notes:

While in Congress, Harrison helped establish three major governmental departments - what we know call the Defense, Navy and State Departments.

He retired from Congress in 1777, returning to his seat in the Virginia house of delegates, where he was elected speaker of the house, and remained in that post for four years. During this period, the British raided and plundered their way through Virginia and the legislature, with Harrison at its head, was forced to flee from town to town to keep from being captured.

LIVINGSTONE'S Supporting Verse

Speaking at the University of Glasgow in 1896 David Livingstone said: "Would you like me to tell you what supported me through all the years of exile among a people whose language I could not understand, and whose attitude toward me was always uncertain and often hostile? It was this: 'Lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.' On these words I staked everything, and they never failed."

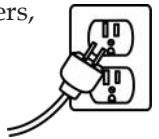
No Power Out, No Power In
