Francis and Richard were the only brothers to sign the Declaration.

Francis was placed at an early age under the care of Dr Craig, a Scotch clergyman of eminent piety and

learning. His excellent tutor not only educated his head but his heart, and laid the foundation of character upon which the noble superstructure, which his useful life exhibited, was reared.

It is said, that he had embraced the religion of the gospel, and that under its supporting hope and consolation, he made his exit in peace from the world.

His last moments were those of a Christian, a good, an honest, and a virtuous man; and those who witnessed the scene were all ready to exclaim, "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his."
