Quotes & Notes:

Jefferson said of Wythe: "Temperance and regularity in all his habits, gave him general good health, and his unaffected modesty and suavity of manners endeared him to everyone. He possessed a way of easy elocution, his language chaste, methodical in the arrangement of his matter, learned and logical in the use of it, and of great urbanity in debate. Not quick of apprehension, but with a little time, profound in penetration, and sound in conclusion. In his philosophy he was firm, and neither troubling, nor perhaps trusting anyone with his religious creed, he left to the world the conclusion that religion must e good which could produce a life of such exemplary virtue. His stature was of the middle size, well formed and proportioned, and the features of his face, manly, comely, and engaging. Such was George Wythe, the honour of his own, and model of future times.

Jefferson also called him, "my second father"

J. Edgar Hoover, former director of the FBI did a study on Juvenile Delinquency. He found of 8000 Juvenile Delinquents only 42 had attended Sunday School regularly.
