**Simple ways to help your
 guest be in church with you
 on Sunday....**

1. Pray for your Guest. Who do you know that needs Jesus? Pray for them regularly. Pray that they will attend a service. Start praying now for God to work on their hearts and be open to the gospel.

2. Speak up with a friendly spirit. If Jesus opened His palms to my nails, then I can open my mouth for my friend. Speak up and ask your friend to church. Anytime there is a meal or a special service at church, immediately think – WHO will I be inviting for this event?

3. Add a caring expression of Love. Offer a cup of coffee after church, or a meal, or a Bible while they are with you. Express your personal interest in this person. Be a true friend.

4. Team up with others. Schedule a fellowship at your home or a coffee shop, and invite your friend. Give them a chance to connect with church people in a non-church setting.

5. Cultivate compassionate habits toward others.

As you go through your day, see people and their needs. Be kind to those around you, and God will open doors for you to converse with people and invite them to church. Show care for by sharing a meal if someone who is sick, a coffee if someone is stressed, an encouraging word when someone is down. There are open doors and opportunities all around us. Your simple, kind invitation to church could radically change someone's life.
