What is the Book of Philemon About?

In his later years (probably while a prisoner at Rome) the Apostle Paul met a runaway slave named Onesimus. Roman law, declaring the slave to have no rights, put him in the place of a mere possession of his master. Thus, for a slave to run away or steal was a crime punishable even by death. For such a transgressor the law held only one hope--for him to find someone to intercede for his reinstatement. A letter of such intercession is the epistle to Philemon.

As we read between the lines we see that Onesimus was a fugitive from justice, having stolen from his master Philemon. We see also that Paul had led Onesimus to Christ. In fact, the whole chain of circumstances behind this epistle is a marvelous illustration of God's gracious providence. It was not by chance that Onesimus met Paul; nor was it by chance that Paul was acquainted with Philemon, a Christian and a member of the church at Colosse.
