Dress and Appearance:

Encourage your girls to bring leggings or pants for under their culottes and skirts in case it is really cold.

Bible Quiz:

II Samuel 23:8-39 & II Timothy 1-4. All campers are encouraged to participate.

Written Quiz on Monday (after dinner). Those who score 70% or higher will earn 15,000 points for their team.

Top 6 will proceed to the final Quiz on Wednesday morning.

Snack Shop:

Open and available throughout the day. After the evening services, specials will be available: nachos, cotton candy, burgers, ice cream and more. Camp t-shirts, hoodies and travel mugs are available in the snack shop.

Timothy & Titus Time:

A time set aside to give the teens a chance to preach and minister in song.
