Hello friends,

We've had an exciting past few months. Thanks for praying for us as we try and finish prepping to leave to get back to PNG.

Here are a few answered prayers:

1. We finally have an appointment with the Social Security Administration. We have qualified for an interview because our situation is dire, according to their guidelines. We are very thankful to be able to get that application out of the way.
2. We have passport renewals submitted. Pray that these will be completed and returned to us soon! We will probably need to send all three of the girls to the PNG embassy for some minor visa work before we can travel back.
3. We have shipped our medical equipment and much of our family supplies over to PNG! It was a huge weight lifted to know that everything is en route to our home in the highlands. Please pray that we would be able to make it back in to PNG in a timely manner. We will need to get our belongings out of short term storage. If they are there too long, it would be problematic for us.

We were able to report and present at eight churches throughout July and August. We were happy to be traveling again. The churches were a great blessing to our family, and we were glad to be able to see some old friends.

We have had a few new churches take us on for support. We are edging closer to our goal, and we just need a few hundred dollars more per month. We are also raising funds to buy a vehicle as we go back to PNG. We are thankful to Chad Wells for the use of his vehicles, but we are now at the point where it would be irresponsible to be in PNG without our own transportation. Vehicles are extremely cost prohibitive to buy. We are looking at vehicles made in the early 1990s that will run us about \$20,000 or more. Please pray that we would raise that. Some has already come in, praise the Lord! Please also pray that we buy the right vehicle for our family. We want rugged reliability, but it would also be nice on the girls if it rides soft; PNG roads can be quite rough!

A few weeks ago, Wiru died. He was the man who gave us the land for our church. He is the human reason that Kumiane was opened to us. We are thankful that he submitted to God, and we were blessed to be able to work along side of him to reach his family, clan, and village. Wiru is missed, and we are sad that we didn't get to really say goodbye. However, we are happy that he has a new body and is face to face with Jesus! Please pray that the church in Kumiane would remain strong through this heartache. Pray for Simon and Tina. Simon is Wiru's son, and he took care of his dad up until Wiru died.

Our heart is definitely wanting to go back to PNG. We are homesick and there is a mountain of work to be done. Pray with us that we would have all of our logistical and financial needs met, and that we can return to PNG soon.
