Friends,

We are getting excited as we edge closer to April. We've been in contact with our representative for our visas. We are currently waiting for PNG to approve adding Madilenne to our work permit as a dependent. After that happens we will be sending all three of the girls passports to the PNG Embassy in Washington DC to have the girls' visas reapplied to their passports. Please pray that all of this goes smoothly and happens in a timely manner. We will need to make plans and get our approvals for quarantine procedures and have negative covid tests as we leave the USA. Please pray that the prices stay low for airfare as well. We are looking at about \$9,000 for airfare and then we have to work out where we are staying when we get back into country.

Madilenne has been doing great in her brace! Thanks for those who've prayed for her. She spent February in the brace with about 2 hours a day of free time. She is now up to about 6 hours of freedom per day. We anticipate one more appointment for her in March, and after that she should be all set to go to PNG! She should be all set for her hips, and we believe that all that medical equipment that was shipped is sitting in Goroka waiting for us to retrieve it.

As we finish up our time here in the USA, we are still traveling around to churches to report and present the work of God. We visited several churches in January and February. We have been promised support by a few new churches, and we had good, encouraging meetings. It is always a blessing being around other saints of God who are concerned about lost souls and our work here in earth.

We are so thankful for how God has led us, even with the delays, even with the health issues, and even with living in our in-laws house while not on the road. A lot of people have shown us grace and love, and we appreciate it all so much as we prep to leave for another few years.

Please pray that all of our preparation is fruitful and that we would be able to fully "roll with the punches" or whatever comes our way. We have tried to lay a solid foundation to reduce our time in the USA and extend our ministry time in PNG.
