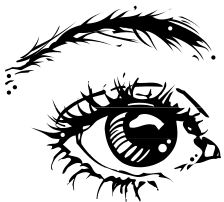

ABC's of the Christian Life for Youth

Did you know that every person born on earth is a sinner? The Bible says that **all have sinned** which would include you and I.



Look up the Bible verses and fill in the blanks. The first letter is given to help you.

Romans 5:12 says, "Wherefore, as by one man s___ entered into the world, and death by s___ ; and so death passed upon a___ men, for that a___ have sinned:"

This verse is talking about Adam, the first man on earth. He and his wife, Eve (the first woman on earth), disobeyed God by eating from a tree that God told them not to eat. They both sinned and because of them, the whole human race are born sinners. No one had to teach you to sin. It came naturally.

Romans 3:12 says, "... there is none that doeth g___, no, not o___."

That means everyone sins and no one is perfect without sin. We all are sinners. We all do bad things that displease God. Some examples of bad things we do are stealing, lying, cheating, disobeying and many more.



God does not like sin, but he loves sinners. Have you ever had a pet? We loved our pet, but we did not like when our pet destroyed shoes. We still liked our pet but hated what our pet did to shoes. In the same way God hates sin and has to punish us for our sin, but He still loves us.

Romans 6:23 says, "For the wages of s___ is d___."

Revelation 20:3 says, "And cast him into the bottomless p___ (A never ending hole)..."
