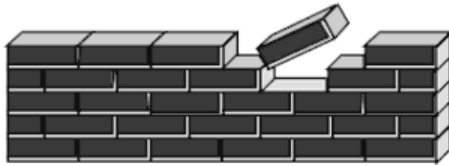


Wall of Letters

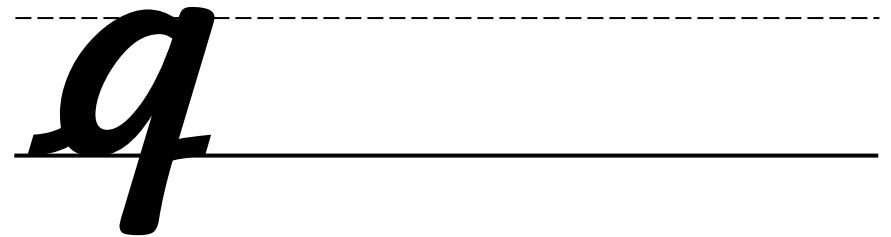
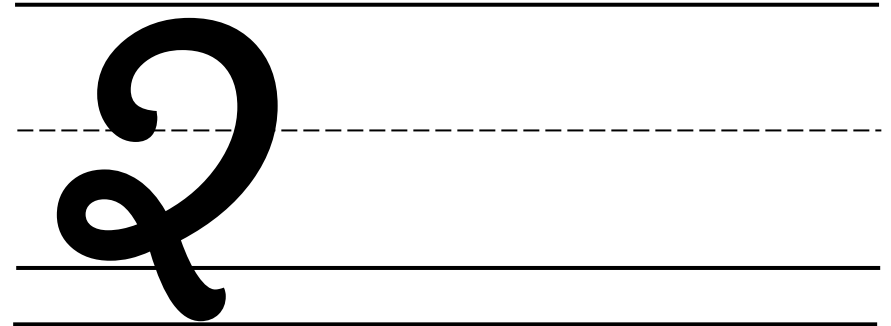

ABC's of the Christian Life for Youth

Many people don't think much about the Holy Spirit. Those who do think are often confused about what or who the Holy Spirit is. Some think the Holy Spirit is a force, like Star Wars.

What does the Bible say? Here are some questions we will try to answer.

Who is He? Where is He? What does He do?

1. Who is the Holy Spirit?



1. The Holy Spirit is God. *Matthew 28:19*, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the n_____ of the Father, and of the Son, and of the H_____ G_____:" The Holy Spirit is not greater or less than God the Father or God the Son. That is why it says "name" not "names" - One God in three persons.

2. The Holy Spirit is a person.

a. The Holy Spirit is always referred to as He, Him or His.

John 14:16 - 17, "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that **he** may abide with you for ever; Even the S_____ of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth **him** not, neither knoweth **him**: but ye know **him**; for **he** dwelleth with you, and shall be in you." You would not call your dad an "it" but "him."



b. He has a personality. You can grieve Him, lie to Him and resist Him. *Ephesians 4:30* "And g_____ not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption." Talk to Him! Most people have forgotten to talk to the Holy Spirit.

2. Where is the Holy Spirit?

1. He lives within the Believer or child of God. *Romans 8:9*, "But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in y____. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his."

2. Our body is the temple or house that the Holy Spirit dwells in. *I Corinthians 3:16*, "Know ye not that ye are the t_____ of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?" He will never leave us. God lives in you if you are saved.

3. What does the Holy Spirit Do ?

1. He had a part in creation - *Genesis 1:2*, "And the e_____ was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God m_____ upon the face of the waters."

2. He wrote the Bible - *II Peter 1:21*

3. He had a part in the birth of Jesus - *Luke 1:35*, "And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall c_____ upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be b_____ of thee shall be called the Son of God."



4. He raised Jesus from the dead - *Romans 8:11b*, "...He that r_____ up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you."

5. He convicts us of sin and things we do wrong - *John 16:8*

6. He seals our salvation with eternal life - *Ephesians 1:13*

7. He prays on our behalf - *Romans 8:27*

8. He comforts us when bad things happen - *John 14:16*, "And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another C_____, that he may abide with you for ever;"

9. He gives us power to tell others about Christ - *Acts 1:8*, "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come u_____ you: and ye shall be w_____ unto me"

10. He shows us how to live right. *Galatians 5:22 - 23*, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, g_____, faith, Meekness, temperance:"

11. He gives gifts and talents to serve the Lord with - *I Corinthians 12:11*

The Holy Spirit does so many things, and He lives inside of you! Talk to Him and let Him show you how to live. *John 15:4*, "Abide in **me**, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in **me**."
