### **THE BIBLE IN LINCOLN'S LIFE**

Abraham Lincoln indebtedness to the Bible is beyond dispute. He read it in his boyhood and its influence over him increased with the years. In his public address, he quoted from the Bible more often than from any other book.

**The Bible influenced Lincoln's literary style, which was modeled on** the writings of the great prophets of Israel. His deeply moving Second Inaugural read like a page from the Book of Isaiah. Lincoln thought in terms of Biblical ideas and convictions to an extent probably unparalleled among modern statesmen.

He was, moreover, a man of prayer, and this without apology or self-consciousness. He did not hesitate to request the prayers of others or to acknowledge that he himself prayed. Prayer for him was a necessity. He spoke of seeking divine guidance, as though it was the most natural and reasonable thing to do.
