
What is the Book of **Song of Solomon** about?

The book is made up of songs, or "canticles," some short and some long. These songs do not tell a consecutive story, but touch upon various incidents and conversations.

The book is a very romantic depiction of the **love of Christ** for the church (His bride) and of a good marriage.
