While setting forth God's awful punishment for Israel's broken covenant, Jeremiah solemnly declared that God would still be faithful. A **new covenant** would replace the old, and Christ, the Messiah, would yet reign as Israel's King.

The history of Jeremiah is a striking example of **faithfulness to God** on the part of the prophet. He wept as he declared the judgment of God's people, and earned the title of **"the weeping prophet."**
