What is the Book of Amos about?

Amos was a native of the little town of Tekoa, six miles south of Bethlehem in the kingdom of Judah. Jehovah took him while he was working as a shepherd, and sent him north to Beth-el, **the center of idol worship** and the residence of King Jeroboam II, who reigned (784-743 BC) over the kingdom of Israel.

At the time Amos was there as God's prophet (about 760BC), the Northern Kingdom (Israel) was at the height of its splendor, prosperity, and power, but alas, idolatry, oppression, injustice, shameless immorality, and daring contempt of God were common sins. Though highly favored and loved by Jehovah, **this sinful nation had to be punished**. The mission of Amos was to expose these sins, and to inform the people that God "will punish you for all your iniquities" (Amos 3:2).

Though Israel was especially threatened, the kingdom of Judah was also warned. The prophecy closes with a beautiful description of **the future salvation of all Israel**.

## You Tell on Yourself

You tell on yourself by the friends you seek,
