What is the Book of Ephesians About?

Ephesians was a letter written in about 62 AD by the Apostle Paul to the church at Ephesus, the Greek city where the great temple of Diana was (Acts 19:24). The theme of this epistle is **salvation by grace** and the **unity in Christ** of both Jews and Gentiles.

Paul had preached the Gospel in Ephesus ten years before, and had built up a large and flourishing church there (see Acts 19:20:17-38). This letter may be the one that is mentioned in Colossians 4:16 as a letter to be read to the Laodiceans. It is probably true that it was a sort of circular letter intended for the true church, not only Ephesus, but at Laodicea, too. Since these believers had been taught by Paul for about three years, they were well able to understand the deepest truths of Christianity.
