
Faith Promise Mission Giving

Glossary of Mission Terms

CANDIDATE SCHOOL - A series of classes missionaries go through with a *Mission Board*, to further qualify them for the *field*.

DEPUTATION* - Literally: "the act of appointing one to represent another." It is when a missionary visits churches, talks about his *field*, and raises *support* (prayer & financial).

FIELD - The country or region where a missionary is going.

Furiough - When missionaries come back to the USA to renew *visas*, for medical reasons, to visit their *supporting churches*, to visit family, etc. Typically, a missionary takes a *furlough* every 3-4 years, and for 6-12 months.

GRACE GIVING - another term for Faith Promise Missions Giving.

MISSION BOARD - an organization that provides help to missionaries, usually by handling their finances.

MK - Missionary's kid

NATIONAL - A native of the country who starts a church in his homeland, or takes over a ministry which a missionary has started.

SUPPORT - A Missionary's Income. Churches send money (usually to a *Mission Board*), and the missionary uses that money to live and work.

SUPPORT LEVEL - A missionary's calculation of how much *support* he needs to raise on *deputation*. When a missionary reaches (or nears) 100%, he can leave for the *field*.

SURVEY TRIP - When a missionary visits the *field* (usually for a few weeks before or during *deputation*) to learn more about the country.

VISA - approval from a country, allowing someone to enter that country for a certain amount of time. Each country has different rules about the time, cost, and restrictions that come with a visa. Covid restrictions also play a big part in visa approval.

A Church's Involvement

PRAYER SUPPORT - Church prays for missionaries, but does not financially support them.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT - Church sends the missionary money, and prays for them. (e.g. we are financial supporters of the Pridgen family.)

SENDING CHURCH - The missionaries' "home church" (e.g. we are the sending church of the Dye family.)

*Deputation

FULL-TIME DEPUTATION - When missionaries sell their homes and quit their jobs to travel around the U.S. and raise *support*.

PART-TIME DEPUTATION - When the missionary still has a job and home, but visits churches to raise *support*, usually on the weekends.
