I. Grace In The New Testament

We are said to be "not under the Law, but under Grace" in the New Testament age of the Church. What then is this Grace that we are under? (Romans 6:14-15) "Grace" comes from a Greek word "Charis" which means:

- a. "The Divine influence upon the heart, and its reflection in the life," by the Strongs Concordance.
- b. "Divine favor that practically affects the spiritual state of those who have experienced its excercise; enpowering and equipping them for service," from Vines Expository Dictionary of Greek words.

God the Father: Romans 5:15, 1 Corinthians 3:10; James 4:6, 1 Peter 5:5. God the Son: 1 Corinthians 1:4, Ephesians 4:7, 2 Thessalonians 1:12.

God the Holy Spirit: Hebrews 10:29
