## Proverbs 1

II ${ }^{1}$ The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel; ${ }^{2}$ To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; ${ }^{3}$ To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity; ${ }^{4}$ To give subtilty to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. ${ }^{5} \mathrm{~A}$ wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels: ${ }^{6}$ To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings.

II ${ }^{7}$ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction. ${ }^{8} \mathrm{My}$ son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: ${ }^{9}$ For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.
$I^{10}$ My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not. ${ }^{11}$ If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk privily for the innocent without cause: ${ }^{12}$ Let us swallow them up alive as the grave; and whole, as those that go down into the pit: ${ }^{13} \mathrm{We}$ shall find all precious substance, we shall fill our houses with spoil: ${ }^{14}$ Cast in thy lot among us; let us all have one purse: ${ }^{15} \mathrm{My}$ son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path: ${ }^{16}$ For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood. ${ }^{17}$ Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird. ${ }^{18}$ And they lay wait for their own blood; they lurk privily for their own lives. ${ }^{19}$ So are the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; which taketh away the life of the owners thereof.
