Proverbs 10:

<sup>22</sup> The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.

<sup>23</sup> It is as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.

<sup>24</sup> The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.

<sup>25</sup> As the whirlwind passeth, so is the wicked no more: but the righteous is an everlasting foundation.

<sup>26</sup> As vinegar to the teeth, and as smoke to the eyes, so is the sluggard to them that send him.

<sup>27</sup> The fear of the LORD prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.

<sup>28</sup> The hope of the righteous shall be gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish.

<sup>29</sup> The way of the LORD is strength to the upright: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity.

<sup>30</sup> The righteous shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth.

<sup>31</sup> The mouth of the just bringeth forth wisdom: but the froward tongue shall be cut out.

<sup>32</sup> The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked speaketh frowardness.
