Proverbs 14:

<sup>1</sup> Every wise woman buildeth her house: but the foolish plucketh it down with her hands.

<sup>2</sup> He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the LORD: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him.

<sup>3</sup> In the mouth of the foolish is a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them.

<sup>4</sup> Where no oxen are, the crib is clean: but much increase is by the strength of the ox.

<sup>5</sup> A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies.

<sup>6</sup> A scorner seeketh wisdom, and findeth it not: but knowledge is easy unto him that understandeth.

<sup>7</sup> Go from the presence of a foolish man, when thou perceivest not in him the lips of knowledge.

<sup>8</sup> The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is deceit.

<sup>9</sup> Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is favour.

<sup>10</sup> The heart knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy.

<sup>11</sup> The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish.

<sup>12</sup> There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

<sup>13</sup> Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that mirth is heaviness.

<sup>14</sup> The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways: and a good man shall be satisfied from himself.

<sup>15</sup> The simple believeth every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going.

<sup>16</sup> A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident.

<sup>17</sup> He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

<sup>18</sup> The simple inherit folly: but the prudent are crowned with knowledge.
