## Proverbs 14:

${ }^{19}$ The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the righteous.
${ }^{20}$ The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich hath many friends.
${ }^{21} \mathrm{He}$ that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he.
${ }^{22}$ Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good.
${ }^{23}$ In all labour there is profit: but the talk of the lips tendeth only to penury.
${ }^{24}$ The crown of the wise is their riches: but the foolishness of fools is folly.
${ }^{25} \mathrm{~A}$ true witness delivereth souls: but a deceitful witness speaketh lies.
${ }^{26}$ In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.
${ }^{27}$ The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.
${ }^{28}$ In the multitude of people is the king's honour: but in the want of people is the destruction of the prince.
${ }^{29} \mathrm{He}$ that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalteth folly.
${ }^{30} \mathrm{~A}$ sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones.
${ }^{31} \mathrm{He}$ that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.
${ }^{32}$ The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his death.
${ }^{33}$ Wisdom resteth in the heart of him that hath understanding: but that which is in the midst of fools is made known.
${ }^{34}$ Righteousness exalteth a nation: but $\sin$ is a reproach to any people.
${ }^{35}$ The king's favour is toward a wise servant: but his wrath is against him that causeth shame.
