Proverbs 21:

<sup>1</sup> The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.

<sup>2</sup> Every way of a man is right in his own eyes: but the LORD pondereth the hearts.

<sup>3</sup> To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

<sup>4</sup> An high look, and a proud heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin.

<sup>5</sup> The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness; but of every one that is hasty only to want.

<sup>6</sup> The getting of treasures by a lying tongue is a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death.

<sup>7</sup> The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.

<sup>8</sup> The way of man is froward and strange: but as for the pure, his work is right.

<sup>9</sup> It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.

<sup>10</sup> The soul of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbour findeth no favour in his eyes.

<sup>11</sup> When the scorner is punished, the simple is made wise: and when the wise is instructed, he receiveth knowledge.

<sup>12</sup> The righteous man wisely considereth the house of the wicked: but God overthroweth the wicked for their wickedness.

<sup>13</sup> Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard.

<sup>14</sup> A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.

<sup>15</sup> It is joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity.

<sup>16</sup> The man that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation of the dead.
