Proverbs 22:

<sup>1</sup> A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favour rather than silver and gold.

<sup>2</sup> The rich and poor meet together: the LORD is the maker of them all.

<sup>3</sup> A prudent man foreseeth the evil, and hideth himself: but the simple pass on, and are punished.

<sup>4</sup> By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.

<sup>5</sup> Thorns and snares are in the way of the froward: he that doth keep his soul shall be far from them.

<sup>6</sup> Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

<sup>7</sup> The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.

<sup>8</sup> He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail.

<sup>9</sup> He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor.

<sup>10</sup> Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

<sup>11</sup> He that loveth pureness of heart, for the grace of his lips the king shall be his friend.

<sup>12</sup> The eyes of the LORD preserve knowledge, and he overthroweth the words of the transgressor.

<sup>13</sup> The slothful man saith, There is a lion without, I shall be slain in the streets.

<sup>14</sup> The mouth of strange women is a deep pit: he that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.

<sup>15</sup> Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
