Proverbs 23:

<sup>19</sup> Hear thou, my son, and be wise, and guide thine heart in the way.

<sup>20</sup> Be not among winebibbers; among riotous eaters of flesh:

<sup>21</sup> For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe a man with rags.

<sup>22</sup> Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.

<sup>23</sup> Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.

<sup>24</sup> The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begetteth a wise child shall have joy of him.

<sup>25</sup> Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bare thee shall rejoice.

<sup>26</sup> My son, give me thine heart, and let thine eyes observe my ways.

<sup>27</sup> For a whore is a deep ditch; and a strange woman is a narrow pit.

<sup>28</sup> She also lieth in wait as for a prey, and increaseth the transgressors among men.

<sup>29</sup> Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes?

<sup>30</sup> They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.

<sup>31</sup> Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright.

<sup>32</sup> At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder.

<sup>33</sup> Thine eyes shall behold strange women, and thine heart shall utter perverse things.

<sup>34</sup> Yea, thou shalt be as he that lieth down in the midst of the sea, or as he that lieth upon the top of a mast.

<sup>35</sup> They have stricken me, shalt thou say, and I was not sick; they have beaten me, and I felt it not: when shall I awake? I will seek it yet again.
