Proverbs 29:

- ¹⁴The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever.
- ¹⁵ The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.
- ¹⁶When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increaseth: but the righteous shall see their fall.
- ¹⁷ Correct thy son, and he shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul.
- ¹⁸ Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.
- ¹⁹ A servant will not be corrected by words: for though he understand he will not answer.
- ²⁰ Seest thou a man that is hasty in his words? there is more hope of a fool than of him.
- ²¹ He that delicately bringeth up his servant from a child shall have him become his son at the length.
- ²² An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.
- ²³ A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.
- ²⁴ Whoso is partner with a thief hateth his own soul: he heareth cursing, and bewrayeth it not.
- ²⁵ The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.
- ²⁶ Many seek the ruler's favour; but every man's judgment cometh from the LORD.
- ²⁷ An unjust man is an abomination to the just: and he that is upright in the way is abomination to the wicked.
