<sup>1</sup>The words of king Lemuel, the prophecy that his mother taught him.

<sup>2</sup>What, my son? and what, the son of my womb? and what, the son of my vows?

<sup>3</sup> Give not thy strength unto women, nor thy ways to that which destroyeth kings.

<sup>4</sup> It is not for kings, O Lemuel, it is not for kings to drink wine; nor for princes strong drink:

<sup>5</sup> Lest they drink, and forget the law, and pervert the judgment of any of the afflicted.

<sup>6</sup> Give strong drink unto him that is ready to perish, and wine unto those that be of heavy hearts.
